French Supermarket Chain Système U Deploys ROBO in 1500 Stores



- Système U is a French retailers' cooperative, comprising about 1,600 hypermarkets and super markets.
- It owns the trademarks Hyper U, Super U, Marché U and Utile. It has a pre-tax turnover of 15.6 billion EUR in 2007 which makes the company the 6th largest retail group in France.

Challenges

- Système U is the fourth largest retail chain in France with a total of 1,600 stores and 40,000 employees.
- As Système U stores does not have dedicated IT rooms or IT technician, the new servers are required to be quietly working and easy to manage in the store office.
- In the next 3 years, the new types of services (such as office automation, finance, video surveillance, VDI, and file sharing) will be adopted with the further requirement of High Availability.

Solution

- Système U HQ purchases thousands of Huawei RH1288 V3 servers and deploys 1 or 2 servers in each store to operate the business, including daily accounting, video surveillance and bar code management.
- Système U HQ manages all these servers centrally via eSight and performs unified monitoring, alarm handling and O&M. RH1288 V3 servers can operate reliably with low noise under office circumstance due to the unique heat dissipation design and intelligent fan speed adjustment rules.
- With high computing density and well-balanced configurations of memory, storage, and PCIe, RH1288 V3 servers can adapt to various resource demands in different working environments.

Challenges

- ECI's existing system needs to process sales data of hundreds of online and offline sales channel, inventory data of 38 logistics centers, and membership data. Sales data processing has become its bottleneck.

- The original scale-out architecture result in some issues including complicated O&M of various servers and the impact of inter-HANA node data exchange on performance, leading to poor O&M experience.
